



The Department of Psychiatry at the Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center is seeking **two tenure or non-tenure track faculty psychologists** to join our team and help expand the mental and behavioral health services of children, adolescents, and families in West Texas. This position will also include involvement in programs recently developed by the Texas Child Mental Health Care Consortium, which utilize telehealth to provide services to youth in school districts and primary care offices across the state. This position will provide a unique opportunity for involvement in the development of an innovative, stepped-care model that includes outpatient, day treatment, intensive outpatient, and crisis stabilization services, all of which will be housed in one newly-developed, state-of-the-art location within Covenant Children's Hospital in Lubbock, Texas.

The psychologists will work collaboratively with a team of providers (e.g., nurses, developmental pediatricians, social workers, marriage and family therapists, licensed professional counselors, psychiatrists) to provide comprehensive, evidence-based care for youth with a range of behavioral and emotional difficulties, as well as medical conditions. The position will include providing and/or supervising evidence-based assessment and intervention services to youth and families, as well as engaging in team-based consultation. Program development will be an integral component of the position, and numerous opportunities for collaborative research are available.

Qualifications include a Ph.D./Psy.D. in clinical, school, or counseling psychology from an APA-accredited doctoral program, completion of an APA-accredited predoctoral internship, and completion of a postdoctoral fellowship. Applicants should be licensed or license-eligible in Texas prior to the start of the position.
