Division 16 SASP Board is pleased to announce the call for proposals for the 2023 Student Research Forum (SRF) to be held during APA's 131th annual convention.

Eligibility for Submission

Consider submitting a proposal if you are a:

- School psychology graduate student
- Applicant recently accepted into a school psychology program
- Prospective student interested in school psychology

Guidelines for Proposal Preparation

Your final proposal submission must include:

- 1. A completed proposal cover sheet (see below).
- 2. A typed, doubled-spaced summary of the proposed presentation (attach as a SEPARATE document from the cover sheet):
 - Maximum of 500 words (title, references, and tables not included in word limit).
 - Description of the nature of research, methodological and/or conceptual framework, significance of results, and implications for school psychology.

Additional guidelines:

- Materials must be submitted electronically to the email addresses provided below.
- Submitted presentations must be original works, and may not have been previously presented at other conferences.
- Please adhere to APA's Ethical Principles of Psychologists and Code of Conduct, specifically Standard 8: Research and Publication when conducting and presenting research.
- Indicate any accommodations that are required to facilitate participation on the cover sheet.
- Each proposal should include an email address for the first author. First authors are responsible for communicating all
 information received from SASP regarding the SRF to co-authors.
- Presenters will be notified by email regarding proposal acceptance by April 30, 2023.

Benefits of Presenting at the Student Research Forum

Participation in the SRF provides opportunities to:

- Disseminate the important work of school psychology students
- Practice presenting research to others and receive opportunities for feedback
- Network with other graduate students and professionals in the field
