



**Child Clinical Psychologist Position
Learning and Emotional Assessment Program (LEAP)
Massachusetts General Hospital and Harvard Medical School**

We are pleased to announce an opening for a **full-time child clinical psychologist position** at the Learning and Emotional Assessment Program (LEAP) within the Department of Psychiatry of Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH) in Boston, MA.

LEAP specializes in the assessment of neurodevelopmental disorders in children and adolescents ages 2-22, emphasizing a collaborative and holistic approach that engages the child, family, and referring provider. Patients are referred by pediatricians, child psychiatrists and psychologists, and child neurologists.

The child clinical psychologist's primary role will be to provide brief, focused assessments to identify the presence of autism-spectrum disorders in young children (ages 2-5). Additional clinical responsibilities may include consultations with families of school-aged children to make targeted treatment recommendations and/or to assist with triage for neuropsychological evaluation.

The ideal candidate will have expertise in the assessment of autism-spectrum disorders in early childhood (ages 2-5). Experience and/or training in the assessment of diverse populations, school psychology, and telemedicine is desired. The psychologist will play a significant role in training, including supervision and teaching of child psychology interns and pediatric neuropsychology postdoctoral fellows.

While clinical care and training will be the primary responsibilities, LEAP has a well-developed and integrated clinical research program. All faculty can collaborate on research projects without the need to secure their own research funding and/or can pursue independent research opportunities.

The position offers a competitive salary and generous benefits. In addition to a staff appointment at MGH, there will be an academic appointment at Harvard Medical School (HMS). Rank will be commensurate with experience but is expected to be at the Instructor level.

Candidates must have completed a doctoral degree in child clinical or school psychology from an APA/CPA accredited program and an APA/CPA accredited pre-doctoral internship. Prior to the start date, the candidate must have also completed a formal one-year postdoctoral fellowship and be licensed in the State of Massachusetts.
